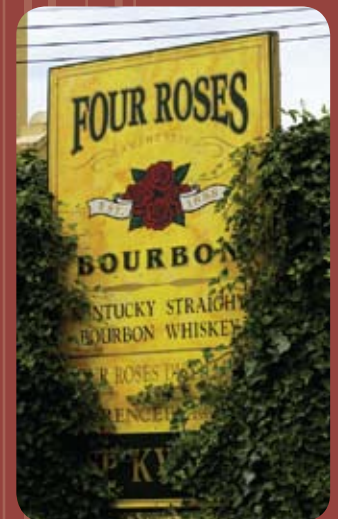
Bourbon Trail Tour

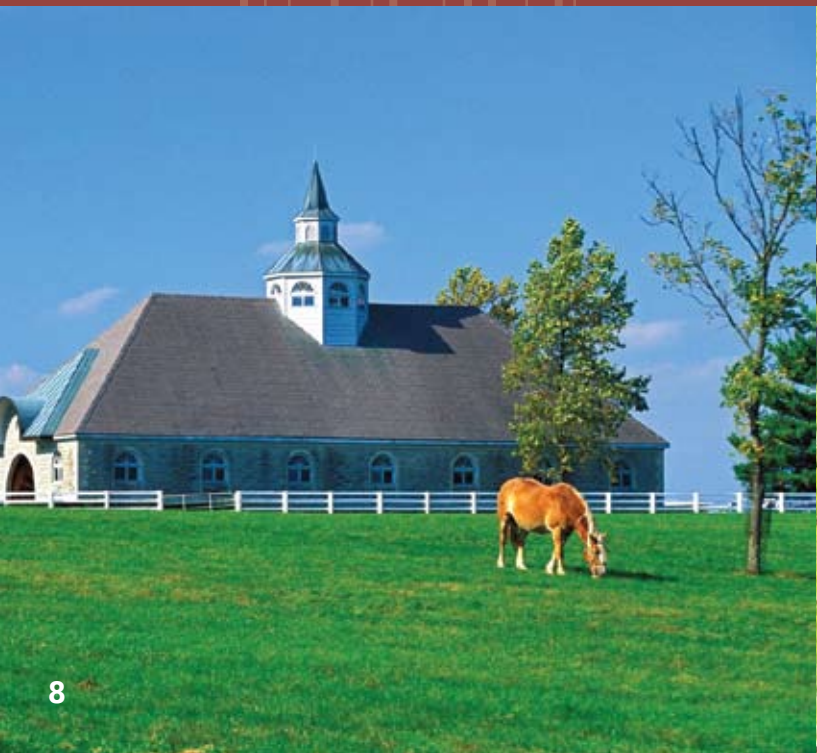
