

## Opportunities for Leadership Development

*SACUBO is only as effective as the quality of the volunteers who agree to serve as members of committees at the regional and national levels. Take advantage of leadership opportunities by volunteering to serve on any of the following committees:*

**Audit Committee**--is responsible for engaging and overseeing an independent accounting firm in the annual audit of the Association.

**Community College Committee**--is responsible for promoting the interests of community and junior colleges and technical institutes.

**Comprehensive College and University Committee**--is responsible for promoting the interests of those institutions given Carnegie Classification as Masters Universities and Colleges I or II.

**Host Committee**--is responsible for supporting the SACUBO Annual Meeting by handling all site arrangements, promotional activities, and social and hospitality aspects of the Annual Meeting.

**Professional Development Committee**--is responsible for providing timely, high-quality, broadly-available, continuing education opportunities for professionals in the business functions of institutions of higher education.

**Program Committee**--is responsible for planning and presenting the professional development program at the SACUBO Annual Meeting. This program should complement the programs of the SACUBO Professional Development Committee in advancing sound principles and good practices of college and university business management.

**Research and Doctoral University Committee**--is responsible for promoting the interest of those institutions given Carnegie Classification as Doctoral University I or II, or Research University I or II.

**Scholarship Committee**--is responsible for selecting recipients for scholarships, as designated by the Board, to the College Business Management Institute (CBMI) and to the Fall Workshop.

**Small Institutions Committee**--is responsible for promoting the interest of those institutions given Carnegie Classification as Baccalaureate Colleges I or II.
